- Preference shall be given to students with a 3.0 GPA or better based on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.

Recipients will be required to attend specified functions and participate in a process to thank the foundation. Funding is renewable annually contingent upon academic standing, conduct, and completion of the required stipulations.
