



It's time to do laundry!

One of the first things you need to do when doing your laundry is **READ YOUR CLOTHING LABELS!** They will tell you how your clothes need to be treated. But what do those funny symbols actually mean? Here's a guide...

As a minimum, laundering instructions include (in order) four symbols: washing, bleaching, drying, and ironing. Dry cleaning instructions include one symbol. Additional symbols or words or both may be used to clarify the instructions. The water temperatures listed below are provided as a guideline. Actual water temperatures obtained depend on washing machine settings (hot, warm, cold), regional supply temperatures, and water heater settings.

WASH Symbols:



Normal Wash



Permanent Press



Gentle/Delicate



Hand Wash



Do NOT Wash

BLEACH Symbols: (when needed- please be careful using bleach!)



Any Bleach



Use only non-Chlorine Bleach



Do NOT Bleach

DRY Symbols:



Normal Dry



Permanent Press



Gentle/Delicate



Do NOT Dry
