Dropping a Class During the

Semester:

If you need to drop or withdraw from a class during the semester, please follow the King University procedure outlined in the Academic Catalog. You will need to notify the VA, School Certifying Official of any changes in enrollment. Changes in your schedule may impact your benefits.

Where's my money?

It takes the VA approximately 6-12 weeks to verify new claims and/or process initial payment. Processing tends to take longer during the fall semester, which is the highest enrollment period of the year. If it has been 6 weeks since you were certified, you may call the VA Benefit Education lin at 1-888-442-4551 to check the status of your benefits.

Change of Major:

If you fall under one of the following categories, you must complete a VA form 22-1195 or 22-5495 (Chapter 35) before benefits can be certified in future semesters.

- Recently declared a major
- Changed program of study
- Change of Site for program of study

An overpayment may result if you receive a grade of I, W or WF, which are not used in computing requirements for your degree program, or if you repeast a course in which you previously received a passing grade, unless a higher grade is that course is required for graduation.

If you recieve an overpayment by the VA, it is your responsibility to pay the VA.
