After college they went their separate ways, James focusing on medicine and Andrew on computer science. Their paths crossed again when James saw the supply chain issues with PPE during COVID and decided to find a solution that would keep people safe and be sourced locally. That is what March 19 Industries is, a new patent pending PPE solution. The system is easy to wear, does not hide any aspect of the human face, has a powered component with a filter that moves air, is lightweight, designed to still allow people to use medical devices while wearing, doesn't

impede communication, 100% permeable, and filters out 99.99% of bacteria and viruses.
