New or returning students, apply for your chance to be awarded a scholarship of \$1,200 per year!

Eligibility requirements:

To be eligible for consideration, applicants for the Scholarship must possess the following characteristics:

1. Meet the minimum entrance and continuing academic performance standards of the University in effect at the time of any award;
2. Maintain full time enrollment at the University, unless he/she has fewer than twice the number of semester hours required to be full time remaining in their degree program;
3. Preference shall be given to a Business, Marketing, or Communication Major or similar for an undergraduate student or a student in the MBA program;
4. Preference given to students who can demonstrate leadership through their involvement in extra-curricular activities including, but not limited to, student clubs and organizations, church, volunteer activities, and/or sports;
5. Hold a 3.0 GPA based on a 4.0 scale or equivalent; students maintaining a 3.0 GPA are eligible to continue receiving the scholarship in subsequent years.

The applicant must review and complete the scholarship application questions that are attached with this form. Questions should be answered in essay form, typed and mailed to the address below or completed electronically and emailed to Micah Crews at mrcrews@king.edu by September 1st.
