Comprehensive Assessment for Core Curriculum: KING 4020

All students must take the OAK (Outcomes Assessment at King) basic subjects test on general education prior to graduation at King University. Associate of Arts students will complete the OAK in the semester they graduate with their Associate's Degree.

Comprehensive Assessment for Major Curriculum: NURS 4990

All candidates for a degree from King are required to demonstrate competency in their major fields. Students will complete a comprehensive assessment during the semester when all major courses are complete. All students must Pass the Assessment according to the minimum requirement of their specific programs. Any student who does not meet the requirement (Pass) of his/her comprehensive assessment will not graduate until the requirement has been met. Registered Nurse students fulfill this requirement by completion of a portfolio assignment.
