

Undergraduate Research Travel Funding Grants

For funding administered by the King Undergraduate Research (KUR) Committee. Other funding streams (i.e. Snider Honors Program and Burke Fellowship) may have different funding caps and requirements. Please contact the program director(s) of those programs or your faculty research mentor for more information.

Grant Amounts

Students presenting their work at conferences or other venues may apply for funds to assist with travel costs. Total funding received is limited to the following amounts:

- Up to \$150 for students attending but not presenting at conferences regardless of distance
- Up to \$300 for students presenting at conferences within a 100-mile radius of Bristol
- Up to \$500 for students presenting at US-based conferences beyond a 100-mile radius of Bristol

In order to serve as many students as possible, KUR Committee grants are limited to one per student per academic year. A second request may be considered on a case-by-case basis as funds allow.

Eligibility

Grants are available for students who meet the following criteria:

- Undergraduate students enrolled full-time at King University
- In good standing academically
- No student conduct violations within the past two academic years, including Honor Code violations

Post-Travel Follow-Up

Students who receive funding from the KUR Committee shall provide a one-page report to the committee outlining how the funds were used, what they learned from their travel experience, and photographic evidence of their participation.

Application Evaluation

Awards will be based on the following criteria:

- Proof of successful acceptance to present at the conference
- Availability of funds
- Faculty mentor approval

Application Deadlines

Applications should be submitted to the committee at least one month prior to the conference/event to guarantee consideration. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis.
